Supportive Policy Environment

Business & Regulatory Reforms:

- 100% FDI permitted in Food Processing, Retails trading including e-commerce
- 40,000+ compliances reduced
- The National Single Window portal hosts applications for approvals from 31 Central Departments and 22 State Governments
- Agro-Processing included in priority sector lending – loans upto INR 100 crore per borrower

Tax Reforms:

- One of the lowest corporate tax globally at 15% for new businesses
- Remission of duties and taxes incurred on exports from India
- 100% exemption of Income Tax on profits and gains for new Food Processing Units for the initial five assessment years

Other Reforms :

- FSSAI Shift from product-by-product approval to an ingredient and additive-based approval process
- Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and small Enterprises (CGTMSE)
